PROGRAM OVERVIEW

TUESDAY - JULY 2nd

Hours: 09:00 am to 06:00 pm (Day), 06:30 pm onwards (Welcome Cocktail)

More details: The day will start with the Pre-Congress at the Zoological Station Anton Dohrn, where registration and accreditation of participants will take place. We also remind you that, during the registration phase, it will be possible to book a visit to the aquarium and museum. At 06:30 pm everyone is invited to the Welcome Cocktail at San Lorenzo Maggiore. To reach the venue (San Lorenzo Maggiore), it is recommended to use public transport, in this case the subway line L2, starting from the stop Piazza Amedeo and getting off at the stop Napoli Piazza Cavour.

More details: The second day of the conference will be held at the prestigious City of Science. The Stazione Zoologica Anton Dohrn is a research institute in Naples, devoted to basic research in biology. Research is largely interdisciplinary involving a variety of fields such as molecular biology, biochemistry, neurobiology, and marine botany among many others. Founded in 1872 as a private concern by Anton Dohrn, in 1982 the Stazione Zoologica came under the supervision and control of the Ministero dell'Università e della Ricerca Scientifica e Tecnologica as a National Institute.

CITTA' DELLA SCIENZA (City of Science) | Via Coroglio, 57/104 - Naples

Opening ceremony | Conference sessions | Poster sessions | Closing ceremony

The Città della Scienza is a centre for promoting and raising awareness about science and technology situated in Bagnoli, a district of Naples.

It offers the most significant Conference Center in Southern Italy. Thanks to its architectural beauty and innovative hi-tech content, the conference centre is a modern and prestigious location with versatile modular and multifunctional spaces, large outdoor equipped areas, and highly specialized services for organizing conferences, gala events, conventions, and temporary exhibitions.

HOW TO REACH NAPLES

From Napoli Capodichino Airport

The closest airport to reach the city of Naples is Napoli Capodichino International Airport.

From the airport, there are two main train lines leading to the city center: the 3S line to Piazza Garibaldi (Central Railway Station) from which it is then easy to take all the buses or the metro leading to the various parts of the city. The 3S leaves every 30 minutes from the front of arrivals, from 5.20 at 23.20, ticket price (Single) \in 1.10 for a single journey.

Airport also has a dedicated **Alibus** line leading to **Piazza Garibaldi** (Central Railway Station, the metro and buses all over the city) and **Piazza Municipio** (city center), in front of the port and the ferries to the islands of the gulf. The Alibus runs every twenty minutes and is in operation from 6:30 am to midnight, tickets cost $\mathfrak E$ 3. Tickets can be purchased at newsstands and tobacco shops of the airport or on board with a surcharge of $\mathfrak E$ 1.

From Rome

If you are flying to **Rome**, you can take a high-speed train directly to Naples.

Many international flights land at the Rome Fiumicino Aiport. From here, you can take the Leonardo Express airport train that takes 30 minutes to reach the main Rome Termini Central Railway station located in the city center. At Rome Termini, connect to a high-speed train to Naples. The entire trip from the Fiumicino airport to the Naples via train will take about three hours.

A number of budget airlines land at the Rome Ciampino airport; from here you can take an airport shuttle bus to the Rome Termini Central Railway station and connect to Naples via high-speed train.



HOW TO REACH THE CONFERENCE VENUES

FROM PIAZZA GARIBALDI (CENTRAL RAILWAY STATION OF NAPLES)

To: STAZIONE ZOOLOGICA ANTON DOHRN (Anton Dohrn Zoological Station) - Estimated time: 25 minutes

Take the **MET train** or the **Subway Line 2** and get off at PIAZZA AMEDEO Subway/MET stop. From Piazza Amedeo, take via Vittoria Colonna and then turn right onto via S. Pasquale. At the end of the street, you will see the Anton Dohrn Zoological Station in front of you, entering the public gardens.

To: CITTA' DELLA SCIENZA (City of Science)

Option n. 1 - Estimated time: 55 minutes

Take the Subway Line 2 or MET train and get off at BAGNOLI Subway/MET stop. From Bagnoli, you will find a free shuttle to the venue "Città della Scienza", at the beginning and end of the day, which can be booked through the registration card.

Option n. 2 - Estimated time: 50 minutes

Take the **Subway Line 2** or **MET train** and get off at MONTESANTO Subway/MET stop. Walk to MONTESANTO Railway stop, take **Railway Line 9** and get off at BAGNOLI Railway stop. From Bagnoli, you will find a **free shuttle** to the venue "Città della Scienza", at the beginning and end of the day, which can be **booked through the registration card**.

Option n. 3 - Estimated time: 25-35 minutes

Take the shuttle bus that you can book via the registration form.

Price: € 15€ round trip

Stops: from the centre of Naples to the venue "Città della Scienza" and vice versa.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

METRO, RAILWAYS AND FUNICULARS

Three underground lines (Line 1, 2 and 6) and four funicular railways (Centrale, Chiaia, Montesanto and Mergellina) support you moving around Naples. Circumflegrea and Cumana are the railway lines that link Naples with the Phlegrean area. Circumvesuviana provides links with the suburbs of Napes as well as with Pompeii and Sorrento. The Garibaldi Train Station provides connections with Campania Region as well as all Italy.

The ticket for metro Line 1 costs only € 1,10!

BUSES

The most useful local transport getting around the centre of Naples are the buses. There is for the first time visitor an impenetrable number of route numbers.

Unless you are staying in a hotel in the suburbs your travel will be in and around the centre of Naples. Here the buses travel down just a few main roads that cut through the centre. For most tourist journeys you will have a choice of several routes to complete your journey.

TAXIS

Licensed taxis in Napoli are white in colour and bear the sign "TAXI" on their roofs. Their license number is shown inside the vehicle on the back left-hand door.

WARNING: Any other vehicles waiting at the airport exit could be driven by unauthorised persons and the fares charged could be higher.






NAPLES - BAGNOLI MAP (Città della Scienza)
